





What is the Mvskoke Fund?


The Mvskoke Fund is a certified Native American Community Development Financial Institution and an IRC 7871 non-profit financial corporation.

Small Business Loan Products & Agribusiness Loan Products

Micro-Loan: A small business loan designed to help with start-up or expansion needs, up to \$5,000.

Development Loan: A small business loan product to meet needs between \$5,001 and \$10,000.

Operational Loan: A small business loan product designed for expansion of business or needed capital. Amounts vary from \$10,001 to \$50,000.
